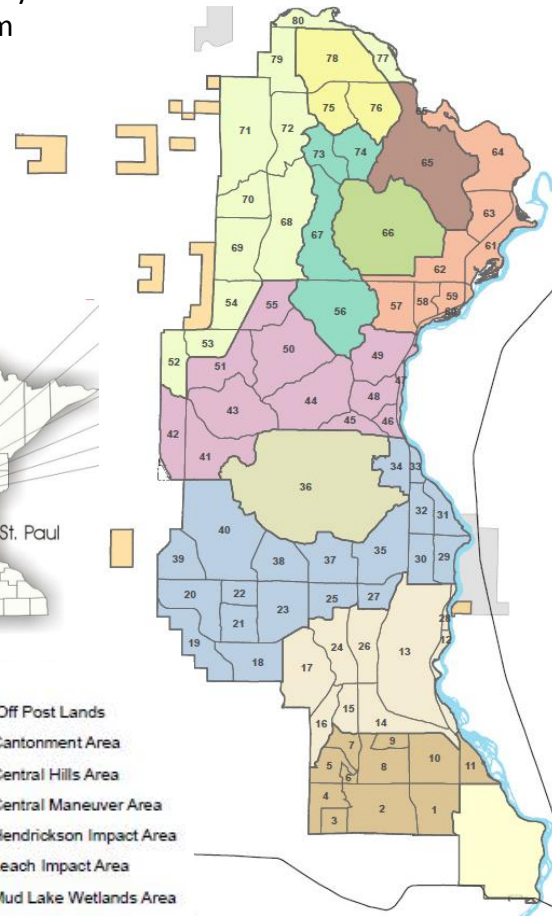
Secretary of the Army, Environmental Security Award
