Removes, repairs, inspects, installs, and modifies aircraft fuel systems including integral fuel tanks, bladder cells, and external tanks. Maintains associated hardware and equipment.

Duties and Responsibilities:

BACKGROUND

In this job, you will perform maintenance on fuel tanks and cells by removing, repairing, and/or replacing malfunction components. Your job will also be to inspect aircraft fuel systems maintenance activities. Additionally, you will be responsible for cleaning fuel cells and tanks, and inspecting for foreign objects, corrosion, cell deterioration, and fungus.

WHAT THEY DO

Aircraft Fuel Systems specialist perform some or all of the following duties:

Perform maintenance on fuel tanks and cells by removing, repairing, and/or replacing malfunction components.

Inspect aircraft fuel systems maintenance activities.

Responsible for cleaning fuel cells and tanks, and inspecting for foreign objects, corrosion, cell deterioration, and fungus.
