Mission

To provide military and commercial access at the Incident Command Site by providing internet access, IP telephone service, video conferencing, and bridging high-frequency military and civilian radio systems

Notes about the JCP:

The Minnesota National Guard has two JCP trailers, both of which were deployed to the Red River Valley in support of Flood Fight 2009. The JCP:

- delivers voice, video, and data connectivity to the public and to the Minnesota National Guard network
- provides on-site and reach-back communications capabilities for enhanced command and control
- facilitates shared situational awareness among first responders, state and federal agencies, and command authorities and centers
- improves interoperability, which helps public safety service and support providers, such as law enforcement, firefighters, EMS, emergency management, public utilities, transportation, and other, each of whom can communicate in real time with staff from other responding agencies
- is fully mission-capable within 15 minutes with a three-man crew from arrival on site
- is Diesel-powered, towed by a 5-ton medium tactical vehicle or civilian equivalent, and climate controlled with directional lighting
